The church is located in Royalton but has a New London address. The church is located on the corner of Church and Depot Streets in Royalton. To get there from Waupaca go east on Highway 54 for about 13 miles. Depot St. is the last street before you leave Royalton. Turn left at this corner and go one block. If you get to the gas station turn around go back 1/2 block. If coming from New London go west on Highway 54 for 6 miles. Turn right onto Depot St. It is the first street past the gas station. If coming from Manawa, take County Highway B south of Manama and into Royalton. Turn left at the stop sign where B joins 54 and go one block. Turn left onto Depot St and go one block to the church. If coming from Weyauwega, turn right onto County Rd. X North of town. Go 3 miles to the Junction with County Highway O. Turn Left onto O and go 3 miles. At the stop sigh for Hwy 54 turn right and go 2 miles. Depot St. is last street before you leave Royalton. Turn left at this corner and go one block. If you get to the gas station turn around go back 1/2 block.
