4-H Horse Association Scholarship

Eligibility:

- A) High school seniors and post-secondary students currently in their first year of higher education are eligible to apply.
- B) A minimum GPA 2.0 out of 4.0 is required to apply.
- C) A minimum of four consecutive years in the 4-H Horse & Pony Project (regular member or horseless horse).
- D) Applicants must attend an accredited, post-secondary school/program.
- E) Applicants may pursue any major.

All scholarship forms and letters of reference must be postmarked by March 1.

Wisconsin 4-H Foundation 2018 Scholarship Application Guidelines

The Wisconsin 4-H Foundation will award more than \$10,000 in scholarships to outstanding Wisconsin students pursuing higher education in 2018. To be considered for financial support, applications must be received by the Wisconsin 4-H Foundation via email by March 15, 2018, 5:00 pm.



Wisconsin 4-H Foundation scholarships are awarded to students based on demonstrated personal growth, development and leadership, academic performance and future educational goals.

To be eligible for Wisconsin 4-H Foundation scholarships, students must have been a Wisconsin 4-H member for at least one year; have a grade point average of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale, and be enrolled or planning to enroll at a university, college or technical school during the 2018-2019 academic school year.

The Wisconsin 4-H Foundation will award more than \$10,000 in scholarships to outstanding Wisconsin students pursuing higher education in 2018. To be considered for financial support, applications must be received by the Wisconsin 4-H Foundation via email by March 15, 2018.
