- Theme: Poster on any general 4-H theme
- Poster must be 14” x 22”
- The purpose is to promote 4-H.
- The contestant’s name, club, age, division, and phone number must be on the back, upper left corner of the poster.
- Include the UW-Extension phone number on the front of the poster in order to encourage involvement.
- All 4-H members are invited to participate in the poster contest. Posters will be judged on October 6th. If you are not able to attend, deliver your poster to the Extension Office by Thursday, October 4th, or it may be brought to the 4-H Pumpkin, Watermelon & Sunflower contest, at the Waupaca Public Library by 1:00 p.m. on October 6th to be included in judging.
- Participants are encouraged to display their posters after National 4-H Week in October.
- Posters will be scored on areas such as:
 - Portrayal of Message/Theme
 - Composition
 - Creativity
 - Appearance
