

HCE Remember When....1956-1970

- 1956** - The new county Home Agent was Kathryn Allen. Mrs. Marlin Steinbach was chosen County President. Office Secretary was Virginia Bowersox.
- 1957** - Miss Rosalee Schmidt was the winner of the Nellie Kedzie Jones Scholarship. The first appearance of the Waupaca County Homemakers Chorus were noted this year.
- 1958** - Miss Kathryn Allen married. Her name is now Mrs. Daile Tubbs. Agricultural Agent is Joe Walker. There are now 6 Center Chairmen for the 6 HCE Centers.
- 1959** - At the Spring Council, plans were made for Achievement Day and the Christmas Fair. New club welcomed are the Merry Mixers.
- 1960** - At Achievement Day our former agent, Eileen Niedermeier, now in Marathon County, gave a talk on India.
- 1961** - Achievement Day was held in the Manawa High School Gym, there were talks on small electrical appliances, a luncheon style show and appeti-teasers as well as a program on "What is Extension".
- 1962** - Donna Ruhland is the new County Home Agent and Mrs. Marlen Boyer is President. At Spring Council a movie "Crown for Catherine" was shown. A skit entitled "Hattie and the Credit Card" was performed on Achievement Day.
- 1963** - Mrs. George Schuelke was the new County President. Achievement Day was held at Iola with Marion Kohlbeck, IFVE speaking on Peru. The title of Home Agent changed to Home Economics Agent. At Fall Council, 56 clubs with 140 members were present.
- 1964** - Our new Home Economics Agent was announced, Mrs. Arlene Unertl. Mrs. Lee Wait was elected President. Miss Mary Kay, an IFYE from England showed slides and talked of farms and homes there. Five homemakers received outstanding service awards.
- 1965** - Four of our members attended College Week for Women. HCE Scholarship Award was given to Miss Catherine Boyer. Fall Council Meeting had more than 100 women attending from 35 clubs.
- 1966** - Mrs. Rolland Paschke was the new county President. Homemakers' Holiday was held in New London on May 18th. Mrs. William Kitzrow delegate to the 11th Triennial Convention of ACWW showed slides and talked about Ireland. Holiday Christmas Fair was held in Weyauwega with 1200 attending.
- 1967** - The first International Chairman was named - Mrs. Rolland Paschke. We had a booth at the Waupaca County Fair. Mrs. Marlene Williams is the new Home Economics Agent. Mrs. Handferd Colden is the Historian.
- 1968** - At the Fall Council there were 75 members from 24 Clubs attending.



Scholarship winner was Kathleen Myhra. Mrs. Mary Jane Seils is the new Home Economist as of November 1968.

1969 - Mrs. Herman Yeager was County President. Our new Home Economist was Mrs. Louise Dahlke. On the State level, we are an organization of 40,000 women.

1970 - State President was Mrs. Marlin Steinbach. County President was Mrs. Allen Ireton. New Home Economist is Linda Reinholz who took over on February 2nd. The International program was on India. Mrs. Garhart Sannes was named the new Central District Chairman. Our newest club was Think Young.
