Ingredients needed for stone soup: Broth: chicken or other low sodium broth(at least 2 quarts)

Vegetables, maybe from your gardens all diced: carrots, potatoes, tomatoes, green/yellow beans, peppers, cabbage, onions, peas, summer squash, celery (No beets, please)

Meat: smoked ham hock or 4 cups cubed

cooked chicken, optional

Fresh herbs: basil, chives, garlic cloves, salt,

pepper, and thyme

Clean stone

Serve with salad croutons and Parmesan

cheese or saltines with butter
