P.S. One of my favorite recipes for the season.

#### **Sweet Potato Casserole**

#### **Filling**

4 T unsalted butter, melted
3 cups mashed sweet potatoes
½ cup milk
¼ cup brown sugar, packed
1 tsp pure vanilla extract
½ tsp kosher salt
1 large egg

#### **Topping**

½ cup flour ½ cup brown sugar, packed 4 T unsalted butter, melted ¼ tsp kosher salt ¾ cup chopped pecans

Directions: Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Butter 2-quart baking dish. Filling: Whisk together butter, mashed sweet potatoes, milk, brown sugar, vanilla, salt and eggs in a large bowl. Transfer to buttered baking dish. Topping: Combine flour, brown sugar, butter and salt in medium brown until moist and the mixture clumps together. Stir in the pecans and spread over the top of the sweet potatoes in an even layer. Bake until mostly set in the center and golden on top, about 25 to 30 minutes. Serve hot.

Note: If you double the recipe for the filling, I have found that the topping recipe is sufficient. You don't need to double the topping recipe.
