





Waupaca County Large Animal Scholarship 2021

Dear Waupaca County Large Market Animal Exhibitors:

The Waupaca County Large Market Animal Scholarship was established to support and reward youth for their market livestock knowledge and participation, leadership skills, and involvement in the community. The Waupaca County Large Market Animal Committee has put \$2,500 toward scholarships for the scholarship committee to disperse at their discretion.

Scholarships will be utilized by recipients to further their education. Applicants must be Waupaca County Large Market Animal exhibitors and may apply for the scholarship the year they graduate from secondary education or the following year. Past recipients are not eligible to compete for this scholarship.

The completed application and one letter of recommendation from a non-family member must be submitted to Bobbie Jo Montgomery, Waupaca Learning Center 1515 Shoemaker Dr. Waupaca WI 54981 on or before March 15 of the current year.

Recipients will be announced during their school award program, broadcasted at the livestock auction at the county fair, and recognized at the Waupaca County Large Market Animal Auction and Large Market Animal Banquet.

Recipients have one year to claim scholarship.
