For outdoor gardening projects that are under 2 hours and under 20 participants, please contact your county coordinator or mike.maddox@wisc.edu for a modified/abbreviated, easy-to-fill-out program planning checklist to submit. All other events continue to require the full program planning checklist. Download Program Planning Checklist (PDF) online.

- You can have up to 50 total event participants indoors (or 30% of room capacity) OR up to 150 outdoors.
- Pod numbers increase to 20, with additional flexibility to have one large group if there is no safety reason to have participants in pods.
- Events can last up to 4 hours.
