United Veterinary Service

United Veterinary Service will once again be offering a \$1,000.00 scholarship to a graduating senior this spring. The scholarship application is available to any student in Waupaca, Shawano, Outagamie, Waushara or Winnebago counties who was enrolled in a supervised animal project in 4-H, FFA or Scouting. There are no restrictions regarding the area of study the student pursues. The application includes a list of the projects the student was engaged in and a short essay about the life lessons learned with the project. The deadline for the completed application is March 31, 2022. Applications can be picked up at the office in Bear Creek or by contacting Extension Waupaca County .



United Cooperative Scholarship

United Cooperative's Scholarship Program awards \$1,000 scholarships to 40-50 high school seniors and current college/technical school students who are continuing their full-time education in 2022-2023. The scholarship application deadline is February 25, 2022. Applicants will be judged on their leadership skills, scholastic achievement, extracurricular activities, motivation, and academic and personal goals. To be eligible, the student or the parent is an active patron member of United Cooperative; Student must plan to attend (or be currently enrolled in) an accredited college, university, or technical school; Student must maintain a GPA of 2.0 or above on a 4.0 scale. 4-H Horse Association Scholarship

Eligibility: A) High school seniors and post-secondary students currently in their first year of higher education are eligible to apply. B) A minimum GPA 2.0 out of 4.0 is required to redeem your scholarship. C) A minimum of four consecutive years in the 4-H Horse & Pony Project (regular member or horseless horse). D) Applicants must attend an accredited, post-secondary school/program (i.e. 2- or 4-year college or professional technical program, Farm & Industry short course program, vocational college or training of at least one school year in length). E) Applicants may pursue any major. All scholarship forms and letters of reference must be postmarked by March 1.

Wisconsin 4-H Foundation 2022 Scholarship Application Guidelines

The Wisconsin 4-H Foundation will award more than \$15,000 in scholarships to outstanding Wisconsin students pursuing higher education in 2022. To be considered for financial support, applications must be received by the Wisconsin 4-H Foundation via email by Tuesday, March 15, 2022, 5:00 pm. Wisconsin 4-H Foundation scholarships are awarded to students based on demonstrated personal growth through 4-H, development and leadership in 4-H, academic performance and future educational goals. To be eligible for Wisconsin 4-H Foundation scholarships students must have been a Wisconsin 4-H member for at least three years; should have a grade point average of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale, and be enrolled or planning to enroll at a university, college or technical school during the 2022-2023 academic school year. Waupaca County Large Animal Scholarship 2022

The Waupaca County Large Market Animal Scholarship was established to support and reward youth for their market livestock knowledge and participation, leadership skills, and involvement in the community. The Waupaca County Large Market Animal Committee has put \$2,500 toward scholarships. No more than four candidates will earn a scholarship, which will be determined by the scholarship committee. Applicants must be Waupaca County Large Market Animal exhibitors and may apply for the scholarship the year they are graduating from high school or the following year. Past recipients are not eligible to compete for this scholarship. The completed application and one letter of recommendation from a non-family member must be submitted to Bobbie Jo Montgomery on or before March 15 of the current year.
