

WAUPACA COUNTY LARGE MARKET SELLING CHECKLIST

Exhibitor must complete all on this list, but it may not be all that has to be done to be eligible to see, please read entire list of rules and regulations.

Participation

- Complete YQCA Training online by August 15, 2022 or in person June 11th at 8 am at fairgrounds.
- Complete 4 educational points (includes 'YQCA) and return sheet to Jen Erb or Bobbi Jo Montgomery by August 15, 2022.
- Attend Ear Tag and DNA sample meeting
 - April 2nd at 9 am to 11 am at the fairgrounds
 - April 21st at 6:30 to 7:30 pm at the fairgrounds
- Hair Samples turned in by May 9, 2022 to Ann Wehrle (see rules packet)
- Must be entered in fair (online registration) by Tuesday, July 14th, 2022
- Swine: PRRS Testing needs to be completed before fair. We will hand out ropes at tagin and they can be dropped off at fairgrounds on June 11th from 8 am to 12 pm.
- Each participant must contact three local business to help promote show and sale. Return the receipt signed portion of the brochure at weigh in at fair.
- Fair animal id & vet check form and Certificate of Veterinarian Inspection (swine only) must accompany animals to the fair before animals will be permitted to be unloaded, within 30 days of the fair.

AT THE FAIR

- All Animals must be weighed in on entry day between 8 a and 3 pm.
- Sale order will be posted on Thursday evening on the showing office. It is the EXHIBITORS responsibility to make sure their name is on the list. Must report to superintendent or Annette any changes by 10 am Friday.
- Make sure you have a place for the non-sale animals to go after the fair, either home or to a butcher shop.
- Sell 5 books of raffle tickets. Turn in at or before the carcass show.

AFTER THE FAIR

- Carcass show will be held Wednesday night after the fair at 6 pm at the fairgrounds
- Thank you notes for buyers must be turned in by September 9, 2022.
- The buyers Thank You banquet will be October 8, 2022
