Who:

Benefits:

What do we do?:

- It is expected that each Ambassador will participate in at least two opportunities each year (in addition to ambassador meetings)
- Ambassador meetings attendance expected (meetings are planned based on the best time indicated by the current group – ideally every other month)
- Supporting county 4-H programs through a variety of assistance (planning, organizing, promoting, hosting, emceeing, teaching, etc.). Examples:
 - Promotion / 4-H programs during County Fair
 - o Elementary School open house, radio program, or other 4-H promotion
 - Attend community events to promote 4-H
 - Ambassador Fundraiser (as needed)
 - o Community Service with Ambassador group
 - 4-H Club visits (in addition to your own club)
 - Teach at Super Saturday, Officer Training, Day Camp, New Family Events, Cloverbud workshops, Record Book Clinic, etc.
 - o Assist at a county event like Music and Drama, Foods Judging, Achievement Night
 - Participate in older youth/family events planned or sponsored by Ambassadors (bowling, ice skating, etc.)
 - Help with fair preparation (for example, youth building set up, painting, etc.)

How to apply?:

- Interested in becoming an Ambassador? Complete a county application and interview (November/December)
- ❖ Brief letter of recommendation from a club leader (1-2 paragraphs) emailed to Penny
