

December Meeting and Christmas Party


It's time to come together and celebrate all that we have accomplished this past garden season!

November 2022 Meeting Minutes

The Secretary's report was provided by Nancy Sonnenberg. The October meeting minutes were posted in the Newsletter. No corrections were noted. A motion to accept the September minutes was requested. Motion moved by Rebecca and second by Carrie.

The Treasurer's report was provided by Rebeca Weber Schmoll and will be filed for audit.

No state update this month.

President Carrie Esch shared the new 2023 MG Certification training event through UW Extension.

Registration for the 2023 onboarding course opens December 1, 2022, ends March 1, 2023. Registration fee will be \$100. The course starts January 17, 2023 and ends March 31, 2023. The course is online and asynchronous. You can complete all aspects of the course at your own pace within the course dates. The deadline to register for the course is March 1. You must complete the course by March 31. Course cancellations prior to the course start deadline of January 17, 2023 will receive a refund less \$20 for processing. No course refunds will be issued after January 17, 2023.
