The December Meeting minutes and the Executive Board Meeting minutes were provide in the Newsletter. There were no comments, corrections or additions noted. A motion to approve the minutes was made, first by Rebecca and second by Connie.

The Treasurer's report was provided by Rebacca Weber Schmoll. A copy of the 2023 Budget was provided as a handout and emailed to members with the last Newsletter. This 2023 Budget was reviewed. No objections were made. A motion was made to approve the 2023 Budget and an all in favor was unanimously in favor, no objections.

Committees and Events

2023 Summer Event Planning Decision to have a MGV Plant Sale on SUNDAY JUNE 4th, 2023 at Deana Hirte's Residence. This will be the same day as the Weyauwega Fireman's Chicken BBQ. Rebecca and Jean S. are the chairs of this committee. Members are encouraged to start thinking of plants that you can bring or neighbors who may have gardens that are in need of thinning. A suggestion was made by Connie to connect with people who were Master Gardeners in the past who may want to contribute plants. If there are plants left over from the plant sale, Doug suggested selling them during the Strawberry Fest held a few weeks later. This event will need "ALL HANDS ON DECK". Please add this to your calendar. Amy in the UW Extension office is assisting with questions, recruitment. Inquiries about the Spring Plant Sale have come into their office.

Waupaca Children's Garden A change is coming to relocate the Waupaca children's garden from Swan Park to the ThedaCare Community Garden. The seniors gardening group will take over the garden/shed at Swan Park (in partnership with Waupaca Recreation Center). Carrie and Doug are working with UW-EX – FoodWise and Living the Waupaca Way on grants to improve the site and establish a children's garden program. More information will be shared in the coming months.

Old Business

Storage Unit Rental review to reach a decision by September. The unit is paid for through February of 2024. Keep a reminder to reevaluate the material in the shed. Is there an inventory list? Is there another option that is less costly?
