Project Checklist:

- 4-H Dog Project Enrollment Form submitted
- Current health papers submitted for:
 - Rabies, DHLLP (distemper, hepatitis, leptospirosis, parainfluenza, and parvovirus)
 - Bordetella (kennel cough)
- Training fee of \$10 per youth member

- Fundraising - \$30/family or Culver's Fundraiser commitment of 2 hours on March 25th. (limited spaces available, must sign up ahead of time).

- 4-H Dog Project Special Enrollment Agreement (if applicable)
- Clean up bags
- Soft training treats
- Treat bag or vest or sweatshirt pocket that has easy access
- Proper shoes (no flip flops, sandals, or bare feet)
- Showmanship
 - -Showmanship lead or special collar and lead
- Obedience
 - 6-foot leather or fabric leash
 - Properly fitted chain or nylon collar
 - If applicable- dumbbell, articles, gloves, etc
- Agility
 - Buckle collar (no tags or attachments)
 - 6-foot leash or slip lead
- 7 training sessions attended for each class
