Waupaca County Master Gardeners - Meeting Minutes Feb. 8, 2024

Secretary's Report by Carrie Hitchcock-Esch

Master Gardeners conducted their Feb meet by Zoom. 10 members were in attendance.

Past Secretary, Nancy Sonneberg did a recap of the Dec Christmas party meeting and Carrie did a quick update of the Jan Board meeting.

Rebecca shared the Treasures Report. Sue suggested that we check on the monies sent to the storage unit, because the check was not cashed for a couple months. Report filed for audit

Budget

The 2024 budget was examined. A change made to the budget is the elimination of the \$200.00 for the executive board. It was decided that the library donation will stay at \$25.00/library and the scholarship stay at \$500.00 for now. If the plant sale is successful these will go up to \$100.00/library and \$1,000.00 for scholarship. Connie stated that she would like to see money spent toward education, on library donations and scholarships. Sue motioned to accept the adjusted budget for 2024 and Joan 2nd the motion.

Plant Sale

Location of the plant sale was a major topic of the meeting. The Waupaca County Park and Rec Dept have recently increased the rental fees for building at the Fairground. The price increases would be a major hurdle to us renting out the educational building for the June 1 and 2 of the plant sale. Rebecca submitted a letter to the Waupaca County Park and Rec Dept asking for complimentary usage of the building, the letter stated the Master Gardener involvement within the County. Jean talked with Pete Bosquez, head of the park and rec board about what we do. Carrie will attend the Park and Rec board meeting on Feb 13, 2024 to represent the WCMGV, and will gather the necessary info before the meeting. Doug suggested the Trinity Lutheran parking lot in Waupaca as a possible Plan B.

<u>Membership</u>

Membership dues brought in \$120.00. Bridget requested an updated membership roster. The April meeting will be an open house for potential members. We plan to have a speaker and a gift basket for a door prize. Rob Zimmer, Greg Blondie and Debbie Krogwold are ideas for speakers to bring in for that meeting. We have \$400.00 for a speaker.

Spring and Summer meeting ideas

Potential summer meeting location are Bees and Blossoms urban farm in New London, road trip to Riverview Garden in Appleton, Thern Farm in New London, Fremont library where we would help them plan out a small pizza or fairy garden.
