1. Not to exceed 12 inches in length or height.

3. One entry per person.
4. Project will remain on display at the Fair.
5. Four cash prizes and ribbons will be awarded by the 4-H Leaders' Association.

Recycling Contest

Do you have a lot of stuff laying around that you don't use anymore? Don't throw it away – Recycle it and enter it in the Recycling Contest during the County Fair.

Who can enter: Any 4-H Member, Leader or Parent!

Rules:

1. Materials used to make "recycled entries" must be used materials.
2. Tags for your name, age, and club can be picked up at the Youth Building Office.
3. No limit on number of entries.
4. Recycle art will remain on display throughout the Fair.
5. Enter by 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, ENTRY DAY.
6. Four cash prizes and ribbons will be sponsored by the 4-H Leaders' Association.

Dressed Zucchini Contest

Who can enter: Any 4-H Member, Leader, or Parent!

Rules:

1. Entries cannot exceed 12 inches in length or 6 inches in width when fully dressed.
2. One entry per person.

4. Your entry will remain on display at the fair until Sunday evening.
5. The Master Gardener's will sponsor four cash prizes.

4th Place - \$1.00
