- Poster must be 14" x 22"

- All 4-H members are invited to participate in the poster contest. Posters will be judged on October 12th at the Pumpkin Contest in Weyauwega. If you are not able to attend, deliver your poster to the Extension Office by Thursday, October 10th.
- Participants are encouraged to display their posters during National 4-H Week.
- Posters will be scored on areas such as: *portrayal of message/theme, composition, creativity, appearance.*

- Intermediate: grades 6-8
- Senior: grades 9 and above

Prizes: All participants will receive \$3.00 cash. Plus, other prizes may be awarded.
