4-H Horse Association Scholarship

Eligibility: A) High school seniors and post-secondary students currently in their first year of higher education are eligible to apply. B) A minimum GPA 2.0 out of 4.0 is required to redeem your scholarship. C) A minimum of four consecutive years in the 4-H Horse & Pony Project (regular member or horseless horse). D) Applicants must attend an accredited, post-secondary school/program (i.e. 2- or 4-year college or professional technical program, Farm & Industry short course program, vocational college or training of at least one school year in length). E) Applicants may pursue any major. All scholarship forms and letters of reference must be postmarked by March 1.

Wisconsin 4-H Foundation 2024 Scholarship Application Guidelines

To be eligible for Wisconsin 4-H Foundation scholarships students must have been a Wisconsin 4-H member for at least three years; should have a grade point average of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale, and be enrolled or planning to enroll at a university, college or technical school during the 2025-2026 academic school year. 
Wisconsin Towns Association Scholarship
